GRAD PHOTO Package: Class of 2025

This package includes your grad photo session **AND** your yearbook!

- Grad Photo Day will take place on <u>Friday</u>, <u>November 29th (PED day)</u> at PCHS. A detailed final schedule* will be provided with your specific appointment time closer to the day. You must arrive <u>10 minutes before your scheduled time</u> in order to make your payment and get ready.
- 2. If you cannot be present on that day, a **retake session** will be offered by Green Apple Studios, but we cannot guarantee that it will be held at PCHS.
- 3. *The FINAL SCHEDULE for Grad Photo Day will soon be posted on the Grad Events Google Classroom.
- 4. The GRAD PHOTO PACKAGE will cost \$60.00 This includes:
 - ★ Your <u>full colour</u> "Graduate Edition" Yearbook
 - ★ The <u>sitting fee</u> for your photo session
 - ★ Personal online access to your photo <u>proofs</u> (Proofs are photo samples. You will take a variety of poses on photo day, and you can order your favourites and as many as you like at your own cost) ***

*** Important: The \$60 does not include grad photo <u>prints</u>, only the <u>proofs</u> – Grad photo PRINTS can be ordered online based on the poses you select.

- 5. You must pay for your \$60 photo package <u>at school on Grad Photo Day</u> by one of the following ways:
 - → CASH
 - → DEBIT/CREDIT CARD
 - → CHEQUE payable to PCHS

- 6. Suggested attire:
 - ★ Grad caps and gowns will be provided (both cap and gown are black).
 - ★ The grad "gown" looks like a robe and will fit over your clothing.
 - ★ You will be wearing a grad robe for *all* of the poses and a grad cap for *some* of the poses.
 - ★ The grad robe has a v-neck, so we recommend that you wear any of the following underneath:
 - Dress shirt and tie. If you do not have one, dress shirts/ties will be provided.
 - A collared blouse (collar will show over the robe).
 - o A black or white v-neck shirt.
 - ★ Portraits are taken from the shoulders up. Some poses will require you to hold up a prop (ex. a diploma).

Please Note:

Your yearbook is a special album for Grads only. In order to document your full year in Grade 11, yearbooks will be delivered in the fall of 2026 (beginning of next school year). You will receive information on when to collect your yearbook next September!
