The LBPSB Summer School Program 2025 is offered online. Students who would like to participate in the summer program must:

- Have access to their lbpearson.ca Google account.
- Have a functional headset (preferably USB) with microphone. The combination of earphones and an integrated mic will also suffice.
- Be comfortable using an online platform to communicate with a teacher, send and receive assignments.
- Have access to an up-to-date personal computer with broadband connection capable of running the latest version of Chrome Web Browser.
- Have access to a personal device (such as a smartphone, tablet, or webcam) that can take clear pictures and upload them online.

Students may only register for a summer course with a failing grade, a minimum grade of 45% and with permission from their home school.

Absences

Summer school classes are designed to maximize the amount of time available to cover as much of the necessary curriculum. It is important that students attend all classes. *After three absences, a student will automatically fail the course and will be removed from summer school.* Attendance is taken daily and phone calls are made home for any students not logged on.

Course Fees

Course fees reflect program duration and number of exams. No refunds will be awarded after the 1st day of classes.

Should your child have an IEP, please email a copy (from the current year) of the document to summerschool@lbpearson.ca before their first class.


Please note, the intent of summer school is to provide students with remedial support to prepare them to successfully complete course requirements the following year.
