

PCHS Juvenile Girls Futsal Team Win RSEQ Provincial Championship!

On Sunday, April 8, 2018, The Pierrefonds Comprehensive High School Juvenile Girls Futsal team defeated # 1 ranked College Laval by a score of 3-2 to take home the Schools' first ever Provincial Championship and the LBPSB's first ever Futsal Provincial Title! The tournament was held April 6-8, 2018 at Academie St-Louis, in Quebec City.

The "Lady Trojans" capped off a spectacular futsal season, with a 34 and 1 record. After winning the St-Laurent Express and St-Hyacinthe Futsal tournaments, the girls went undefeated throughout the Ligue des Champions season, winning that championship by defeating College Ste-Anne in early February.

PCHS earned their Provincial Finals berth by defeating cross-town rivals Vincent Massey Collegiate in the Greater Montreal Athletic Association (GMAA) Regional Championship in March.

This particular achievement was realized over their five years of study at PCHS. Having narrowly missing out in previous Provincial championships, the team was able to put it all together for this one last chance, as most are graduating this summer.

Coach Alex Navarrete credits their ultimate victory to a tireless work ethic and desire to constantly perform better. This Provincial Championship marks the end of an era for this incredible group of athletes at PCHS. In their five years, the core members of this group have won a total of 21 Championship titles – the most by any individual team in PCHS Athletics history!
