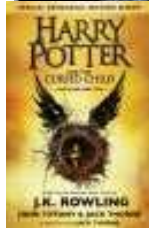
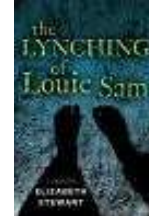

How Does it Work?

- In November, teams will be created in groups of six from all grades.
- If you don't have a teammate, no worries. We can help match you up with a team.
- Teams will be responsible for reading 10 books during the winter.
- Teams will have coaches and will meet regularly throughout the winter to practice.
- Teams can decide how to divide up the books: each read two, for example. You can read all the books if you want but certain students will be responsible for the content for some of them.
- Teams may share ideas about how to remember things from the books and may help each other by quizzing each other. Practice questions will be provided and must be reviewed.
- The School Battle will take place during the week of March 27—31. The team with the most points will move to the Division round which will take place on April 4th at BHS. The top three teams from the Division round will move to the final battle.
- The final battle will take place at the School Board on April 20 at 7 p.m.

What are my responsibilities?

- **REGISTER** at the library. You can either register yourself or your team.
- **READ THE BOOKS** and work with your team.
- **ATTEND** all the meetings and work seriously with your coaches.

What are Battles like?

At the school level, the teams will battle against each other at a date and time to be determined. The team with the most points will move forward to the Division Round.

A moderator will take turns asking questions to each team and if a team cannot answer the question, the other teams will get a chance to answer and gain points. There will also be lightning rounds where teams have an opportunity to gain more points.
