Quebec Education Act**Bill n°56 : An Act to prevent and stop bullying and violence in schools**

“By December 31st, 2012, Quebec schools (private and public), will be required to adopt their first anti-bullying and anti-violence plan, as a result of the *Act to prevent and stop bullying and violence in schools*, which was adopted by Quebec's National Assembly on June 15th, 2012. Introduced as Bill 56, the Act states that rules of conduct for schools now must include behaviour on social media as well. Changes that will sweep across Quebec schools will include the creation of local teams to coordinate the application of the new Act in each school. Principals now have to be supportive of student groups conducting activities to prevent and stop bullying. Schools will also have to take into consideration the best interest of the students when incidents of bullying and cyberbullying occur, of victims and perpetrators alike, especially when it comes to weighing either a suspension or expulsion for the latter. The Act emphasizes the importance of adopting a collaborative environment between schools and community stakeholders.” (definetheline.ca)
